



Tell me how Christian Community Service Center can help...

- ◆ **Emergency Services** helps community members in crisis by offering food, clothing, hygiene items, information/referrals and financial help for rent, utilities and some medical needs. Clients are required to live in our service area (most of the Inner Loop, Near Southwest and Galleria areas): 77002, 77003, 77004, 77005, 77006, 77007, 77010, 77011, 77012, 77019, 77020, 77021, 77023, 77025, 77026, 77027, 77028, 77030, 77031, 77036, 77046, 77056, 77057, 77072, 77074, 77081, 77096, 77098, 77401.
Appointments are required for financial assistance; early arrivals are strongly encouraged for food and clothing requests. Contact 713-871-9741 for appointments, directions and details. Note that we have two locations with different services and hours:
CENTRAL: 3434 Branard St. (77027) Hours: Mon–Fri, 10AM-2PM; and Saturday, 9AM-Noon
SOUTHWEST: 6856 Bellaire Blvd. (77074) Hours: Mon/Tues/Thurs/Fri, 10AM-1PM; and Sat, 9AM-Noon
- ◆ **JobNet** helps unemployed and underemployed persons find work. Participants can receive one-to-one coaching, computer classes, skill-building classes, resume advice, job leads and access to office equipment (copier, fax, etc.). First step: attend Orientation on Monday or Wednesday at 9:45AM. Location: 3224 Mercer. JobNet is not restricted by zip code. Contact 713-626-8320 or jobnet@ccschouston.org.
- ◆ **Martha's Way** is a vocational training program that helps participants learn how to run their own professional housekeeping businesses. We provide classroom education, hands-on training, and job leads. Classes are taught in Spanish: Technical Training, Business Skills I and Business Skills II; "English for Housekeeping" Class is optional. Martha's Way is not restricted by zip code. - ◆ **The Back To School** program serves underprivileged children. CCSC offers school supplies, new uniforms, new shoes and gently-used clothing to 6,500 students in our area. Program registration takes place in early May; distribution in early August. - ◆ **Jingle Bell Express** is a seasonal ministry that furnishes toys, books and holiday meals to 2,500 children. Jingle Bell Express registration takes place in early October, and distribution occurs in December. Contact information and zip codes served: (same as Back To School listing)
- ◆ **The Louise J. Moran Vision Care Program** provides vision screening to students. Follow up visits for advanced exams and prescription eyeglasses are made to the University Eye Institute. - ◆ **Sunshine Resale Shop** is a wonderful thrift store located at 5413 Bellaire Blvd. Donated goods (clothing, furniture, household items, etc.) are sold at low cost to help fund CCSC's programs.
