




Ways to Give

Spread the CCSC Word

CCSC Displays: A few ideas for CCSC displays include: reserving one of three display boards available for check out; creating a bulletin board at your church to highlight a specific program or event; and distributing CCSC flyers for church members to learn how CCSC accomplishes its mission and how they can volunteer.

More Ways To Give

Birthday & Christmas Card Acknowledgements: Are you looking for the perfect gift for a family member and loved one that will truly make a difference? Spread birthday & Christmas joy by making a gift in someone's name. (To send a card designate your Honorarium gift and write "birthday" or "Christmas" in the comments section on the Credit Card form.

Honorarium Gifts: Gifts in honor provide a meaningful, living tribute to a friend, relative, or colleague by commemorating a special occasion. Your contribution will be acknowledged with a personalized card sent to the honored individual or their family.

Memorial Gifts: You can also remember a special person or express your sympathy with a memorial gift. A memorial is a personal remembrance that honors a deceased friend, relative, or colleague. Your contribution will be acknowledged with a personalized card sent to the honoree's family.

In addition, with Birthday/Christmas Card Acknowledgement/Honorarium/Memorial gifts, the name of the individual being honored along with the donor name will be listed in the CCSC quarterly newsletter, Connections. All gift amounts are confidential.

Monthly Pledge: If you are interested in making a monthly pledge to CCSC, please take advantage of the recurring gift option on the online credit card form and the Development Director will follow-up with you.

Matching Financial Gifts: Did you know your donation could be matched with corporate funding? Many companies match their employees' donations to nonprofits with corporate matching funds. Please check with your human resources department to see if your company has a matching program.

Stock Gifts: If you are interested in donating a gift of stock to CCSC please contact our offices to receive the correct forms for transfer.

Shop for a Cause

Amazon Smile: You can support CCSC every time you shop on Amazon! Simply designate CCSC as your charity of choice, and the Amazon Smile Program will donate a portion of eligible purchases to CCSC.

Randalls: The Randalls Good Neighbor Program donates 1% of customers' purchases to up to three nonprofit organizations of their choice. Visit the courtesy booth at your local Randalls to fill out the enrollment form and indicate charity #1439.
