



Program Summary

Christian Community Service Center (CCSC) is grateful to report that we reached the 2019 Back To School program goal, and for the first time services were extended to include high school students: 6,534 students enrolled in Pre-Kindergarten through Grade 12 received new, grade-specific packages of academic supplies and vouchers for new uniforms/shoes.

2,792 of these children (43%) were assisted at our community event on August 2nd and 3rd:

- ◆ These students were pre-registered in April and May, and the program was offered to families living in 33 zip codes.
 - The majority of registered clients reside in the Sharpstown/Fondren area (77036/77074), Gulfton (77081), Greater Fifth Ward (77020/77026), and Greater Third Ward/South Lawn/Foster Place (77004/77021)
 - 51% male; 49% were female
 - 94% of these students were Hispanic; 4% African American; and the remaining 2% of varied other ethnicities
- ◆ More than 6,200 donated “bonus items” including new and gently-used clothing, shoes and accessories were made available to students and family members.
- ◆ 92% of clients who pre-registered attended the event; walk-in clients were also served.
- ◆ More than 900 volunteers contributed approximately 2,700 hours to Back To School 2019, from the registration phase through event clean up.

3,742 of these children (57%) were served directly through their schools. CCSC created these strategic partnerships to support students in targeted areas:
